- We have extended gate times (gates open at 1:00 pm) to help reduce lines. Please plan ahead and arrive early. While waiting in line, please be kind, patient and thoughtful of others.
- Please take advantage of the whole amphitheater. It's huge, comfortable and beautiful! There is plenty of room to move and dance.
- This is an all ages show. However, for their safety as well as the safety of other attendees, children should be supervised at all times.
- Please pick up after your pets.
- Please dispose of all trash in receptacles. Let's make sure the grounds are as beautiful when we leave as when we got here.
