- If you have a fever and/or other COVID-19 symptoms or have had these in the past 14 days, or if you are not fully vaccinated and have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days, please do not come to the show. Tickets are refundable through Ticketmaster.
- If you are not fully vaccinated you are strongly encouraged to wear a mask (cloth or paper face covering) OR maintain at least six feet of social distancing from others outside of your group. Gaiters, bandanas and full-face shields are not acceptable as primary or only face covering. Face coverings should completely cover the nose and mouth. Children under 2 years old are not required to wear a face covering. - We have extended gate times (gates open at 6:00 pm) to help reduce lines. Please plan ahead and arrive early.
- Have your ticket ready to be scanned when you approach the gate. While waiting in line, please be kind, patient and thoughtful of others.
- Please take advantage of the whole amphitheater. It's huge, comfortable and beautiful! There is plenty of room to move and dance. We're bringing out 60,000 watts of Martin line-array PA and a top-notch lighting system, as well, to make sure that the show sounds and looks great from every part of the amphitheater.
- This is an all ages show. However, for their safety as well as the safety of other attendees, children should be supervised at all times.
- Please dispose of all trash in receptacles. Let's make sure the grounds are as beautiful when we leave as when we got here.
